 - You cannot DQ anyone during these 4 meets you learn what to look for
 - Helps you gain confidence
- We have double checks in place
 - o All Disqualifications are Reviewed by a Chief Judge
 - They will help verify the call is correct before a swimmer is DQ'd
- ...and that inevitable day you do make a mistake...
 - o Don't worry the other officials will most definitely poke fun at you over the headsets!
 - But don't sweat it because that's when you know you are part of the team!!!
