



HAWKS Swimming Association Parent Consent Form – Travel

As per USA Swimming’s Minor Athlete Abuse Protection Policy (MAAPP): **“A legal guardian must consent in writing, in advance, for every instance in which their minor athlete travels alone with an Applicable Adult.”**

This form serves as written consent from a HAWKS minor athlete’s legal guardian for their swimmer to travel alone with an Unrelated Applicable Adult on official team travel, and intended to satisfy the requirements in the situation below, taken from the MAAPP FAQs section regarding team travel:

Q: Can Applicable Adults ride alone in a vehicle with a minor athlete?

A: Applicable Adults must not ride in a vehicle alone with an unrelated minor athlete, absent emergency circumstances, and must always have at least two minor athletes or another adult in the vehicle, unless agreed to in writing by the minor athlete’s legal guardian.
